The British Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons has a number of methods of supporting Student Members of our Association. However, these are designed to support trainees who are undertaking their second degree and have been put in place in recognition of the particularly onerous nature of training requiring dual qualification (BDS and MBBS). The majority of our Student Members are studying medicine, having already taken their dental degree, but we do also have some who hold their MBBS and are returning to full time study for their BDS.

BAOMS Student Members are entitled to substantially reduced (in some cases, waived) attendance fees for the Association's meetings, and can also apply to have their membership subscription waived for each full year of their studies. The Association also awards up to ten £2,000 bursaries which BAOMS Student Members are eligible to apply for.
